

#### **SUMMER CAMP 2024**

The Sunflower Preschool Summer Camp has been a well-run, outdoor oriented, engaging and fun summer experience for young children since 1985. Each day at Sunflower we emphasize the simple joys of summer with lots of time for: water play, gardening, walks, outdoor projects and child-directed exploration of our multi-dimensional play areas and gardens. At the same time, we offer a Montessori-based classroom with a science themed curriculum.

During the summer months we study bugs, insects, the rainforest, oceans, ocean animals, and the natural environment. In addition to the child-directed classroom setting, we have a Science Room designed as a hands-on Children's Museum for further discovery. Our staff at Sunflower is year-round and comprised of well-educated professional teachers.

# Sunflower Preschool Summer Camp 2024

#### WELCOME!

The Summer program emphasis at Sunflower is on outdoor activities. At Sunflower we like to spend much of the summer outdoors (especially in the cool mornings). We enjoy taking walks (to nearby Martin Park), gardening, and learning about native plants and animals. We have indoor and outdoor craft projects and planting projects. We have ample water play, and create castles in the sandbox. Summers are low-key and relaxing. We look forward to having you this summer.

#### SUMMER CURRICULUM

We have created an outdoor classroom at Sunflower with many different gardens, the berm ecosystem, and stimulating play areas. Gardening, ecology, and the environment are all integral parts of the Sunflower curriculum throughout the school year. However, Summer is the time of year to explore the outdoors through hands-on, experiential and child-directed free play. We encourage this exploration through frequent walks, large blocks of uninterrupted outdoor play, gardening, outdoor art/science activities, water play, and the theme curriculum. The Summer 2024 curriculum will be bugs, insects, and the rainforest, oceans and ocean animals, and water.

#### **TUITION**

<u>DUE FOR SUMMER CAMP - 50% tuition is due by March 1<sup>st</sup>; the other 50% is due by April 1<sup>st</sup>.</u> Please be prompt with your payments regardless of vacations. If you sign up for Summer Camp after April 1<sup>st</sup>, the total tuition is due upon enrollment.

## **CHANGES OF VACATION PLANS/ REFUNDS/ MISSED DAYS**

We <u>cannot issue refunds</u> if you change your plans. We do not give make up days or refunds for missed days. We understand that summer plans often change, however, we need summer camp schedules <u>by</u> February 15<sup>th</sup>.



## **SUMMER CAMP REMINDERS: PLEASE SAVE!!**

#### \*SUNSCREEN

Colorado sun is very strong, and the skin cancer statistics for the state are alarming. EVERY CHILD NEEDS SUNSCREEN EVERY DAY, THROUGHOUT THE SUMMER. Parents please apply the first coat on your child at the start of the day (before school if possible), and teachers supervise the reapplication of sunscreen throughout the day as needed. All children need to have a labeled bottle of sunscreen at school. We are required by law to store sunscreen in separate containers not in the children's cubbies or lunchboxes.

## \*SUMMER CLOTHING

Colorado weather can change rapidly. Children often need light clothing, a swimsuit, sweat pants and a jacket all the same day. Make sure that your child has a complete change of clothes at school, and wears appropriate layers every day. A hat daily to protect from the sun is required. (Please buy a few hats so one is always in your child's cubby). Summer shoes are a big issue because children take their shoes off constantly throughout the day. Your child needs shoes s/he can take on and off independently of a teacher.

\*LABEL EVERYTHING! Please put your child's name in all clothing, hats, towels, etc. Remember summers are fun, wild and messy so clothing should be suitable for mud and sand play, <u>as well as</u> hot or cool wet weather.

## \*Water Play / Sprinklers

We have water play each day at Sunflower, which includes water tables, a mister in the sandbox, and some days sprinklers and a water slide!

Please send your child in quick dry clothing with good sun protection, as they'll likely get wet several times throughout the day. Bathing suits are also okay, but it's easiest for children if they don't need to change often. Extra clothing is needed each day

Children need sandals, water shoes or easy on/off athletic shoes, clothing that can get wet. Practice at home so your child can take his/her shoes off and on by themselves. Bare feet are allowed in the front grass and sandbox only. This rule is for your child's protection. Please discuss this with your child.

## \*FIELD TRIPS

We take weekly walking trips to Martin Park.



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#### \*UNATTENDED PLAY

Children may not play unattended in the play yard when parents are in the school. Also, <u>children</u> <u>may not go past the red line or out the front gate without a parent or babysitter</u>. Please discuss this safety rule with your child.

#### \*BERM

Please do not allow your child to play on the berm or play on any of the berm rocks and around the fountain area.

#### \*TUITION

50% of the total tuition is due by March 1st and the other 50% is due by April 1st.

#### \*WATER BOTTLES

Labeled, easily managed, child sized water bottles are required for each child during the summer months. The labeled bottle will be stored in each child's labeled cubby and used for walks to the park, etc. Please note, children need a drink with their lunch every day, <u>in addition</u> to their labeled water bottles.

#### \*LATE PICKUP

All children need to be picked up promptly. Remember to read the late fees policy sheet in your enrollment packet or posted on the bulletin board. (LATE FEES WILL BE CHARGED).

#### \*LUNCH

Children need a nutritious lunch in a labeled lunch box. Please include a cloth napkin, utensils, protein, fruit/veggie and a drink. Keep it cool with an ice pack. For more info please see our lunch handout sheet.

## \*TOILET LEARNING

Children should be potty-trained before starting at Sunflower. We do realize that enrollment commitments may need to be made before potty-training has been completed and understand that some transition time may be necessary. We are a child-directed environment in the Montessori tradition where children are encouraged to be independent within our multi-dimensional Indoor/Outdoor environment. Children who are potty-trained at enrollment tend to be more successful at Sunflower. If you have any questions about your child's potty-training please speak to a Sunflower teacher before enrollment to develop a potty-training plan.

Fully potty-trained children are able to: go to the bathroom when they need to, use the bathroom during potty calls, sit on the toilet independently, pull their pants off and on, flush the toilet, and wash their hands. As noted above, at Sunflower we understand that potty-training is a process. Younger children who enroll may still need help with some of the above, however we do expect that children show improvement and demonstrate attempts at independence. In the event that a child has repeated accidents, the teachers and parents will develop a plan which may include: the parent coming to Sunflower to change their child when an accident occurs, evaluating potty-training techniques and



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consistency at home, and/or taking a brief period where the child stays at home until they are able to use the potty. Since 1981 we have welcomed children with unique needs and learning styles including children with special needs. We do not discriminate against children with disabilities according to the American Disabilities Act. If a child is unable to use the bathroom due to a disability, Sunflower will not discriminate against the child.
